



Additional Course Costs

As well as the course fees you will also incur additional financial commitments during the counselling training:

Personal counselling

Students are required to have 35 hours counselling each year of training in order to gain the BSc (Hons). Counsellors' fees vary. You will normally pay between £50 - £65 per session although some counsellors may offer a lower figure for students in training. You can expect to pay approx. £1850 for personal counselling per year.

Supervision

A ratio of one supervision hour to six client hours is required on commencement of placement hours, which is generally by Christmas of Year 2. This then needs to be maintained throughout the remainder of training and until registration with UKCP as a Psychotherapeutic Counsellor (on completion of 450 clinical hours)

Students are required to have supervision fortnightly until they have reached 100 clinical hours, then it can become monthly but at the same rate of 1:6 You can expect to pay approx. £50 fortnightly (approx. £1250) per year for supervision.

Sometimes supervision is paid for by the placement, but this is becoming increasingly rare.

Professional membership

Belonging to a professional organisation is necessary. Currently UKCP trainee membership costs £75 per year or BACP student membership £92 per year.

Professional insurance

You may also need to provide your own professional indemnity insurance if the placement does not provide cover this is at a cost of approx. £70 per year.

Travel costs

You will have to pay your travel costs to the training venue and also to your placement, supervision and personal counselling. There is a charge for parking in local car parks (on Saturdays) in Wymondham.

Books

We have a well-stocked library, but you may want to purchase your own books, particularly in Years 2 and 3.

IT equipment

You will need a computer and printer and will need Microsoft Word. We also recommend having a scanner.

Printing

We provide many handouts and pre reading material, but you may have to print out some course material and you will be expected to meet this cost.

Part-time Pathway

If you need to take the part time pathway (this is a year out of study to re-take parts of a module that have not been passed) there is a fee of £500.

Please note that if you are in receipt of a student loan and take the part time pathway you will not be eligible for any student funding from Student Finance England, including a maintenance loan during that year out of study.

Academic support in preparation for writing the BSc case study

To enhance your theoretical understanding and/or support your planning for writing the case study, you may wish to engage an academic supervisor. This may be for a time-limited contract of weeks/months. Similar costs will apply to clinical supervision (above).

Posting of BSc case study and portfolio documentation, when complete

You will be required to send your final submission of the BSc case study, together with supporting documentation, by Recorded Delivery.

Middlesex Graduation Cost

Students received a free ticket to the Middlesex graduation ceremony but may have to pay for gown hire. Two guest tickets for the ceremony are available at £30 per guest (currently) payable to Middlesex University. You will also have to pay your travel costs to attend the graduation in Hendon.

Matrix Graduation

Matrix graduates get a free ticket to the graduation celebration. There is a £5 charge for each guest.

Please note that whilst we make every effort to keep the tuition fees the same each year there may be an increase in line with inflation from year to year.
